Household rules:

We would like to welcome you to our holiday home. In order to keep the stay as pleasant as possible for you but also for those after you, we would like to ask you to take the following things into account:

1. Although it is not forbidden for your dog to do his or her needs outside the terrain (along the public road) we would like to ask you to keep this to a minimum and you would rather clean up the droppings. You will understand that if a number of dogs defecate here a number of times a day, it can (especially in hot weather) lead to vermin and foul odours which is not pleasant for our neighbours either.

2. In the garden and on the playground you can clean up the dog's droppings with a poop bag and throw it tied up in the dustbin provided. The collected used bags at your gîte can be added when you have an almost to the almost full pink bag, these pink bags go with the garbage to be burned (you will be informed about this upon arrival).

3. Especially in the summer period, we would like to urge you not to smoke outside the grounds, especially in the woods. When smoking on the grounds and in the garden, we would like to point out that your cigarette butts must be cleaned up. Smoking is not allowed in the gîte!

4. This applies to all waste. Keep the Morvan and our grounds clean. Empty glass bottles and paper should be cleaned up by yourself, these are not allowed in the garbage bags.

5. Please do not leave food in the house (at least not without consultation with us) and certainly not a full garbage bag in the bin.

At Gouloux there is a large brown garbage bin, this serves to collect all (full and tied up) color bags until Thursday when the garbage service collects according to schedule. The bags may then be placed on the road where the other residents put their bags. On the Saturday of departure, we collect the garbage and make sure it is neatly processed.

6. Leave the house clean and tidy, i.e. in accordance with the cleaning checklist in the holiday home.

7. If we find that things are damaged, we will deduct the cost from the deposit. We will inform you about this within 2 days after departure.

8. If we find that items have disappeared, the same applies as under 7.

9. If we are need to clean the house for more than 1 hour, we will deduct at least €50 cleaning costs from the deposit (depending on the condition of the house).

10. We ask you to take into account that the Morvan is a nature reserve and expect you to behave in nature with respect for all that lives and flourishes.

11. In the house is an information folder available, it is not intended that you take any leaflets or walkingroutes after the holiday. Please keep it complete and in the gîte.

12. For your safety we have two safety vests in the cottage, as you will notice it is very dark here in the evening.

13. We ask you in the evening or in case of rain/storm to bring in the chair cushions and hammock and close the parasol.

14. When you have used the flashlight, please do not put it down with the glass down, because the heat can cause the glass to break. We also kindly ask you to charge the lamp when it is empty so that the tenants after you can use the lamp immediately.

15. At the start of the rental period we will supply wood for the wood stove (only in the colder periods) with sufficient supply of firelighters and kindling. When the wood is in danger of running out you can let us know and we will replenish the stock. Lighting blocks and kindling can be purchased at various shops (e.g. Weldom Saulieu) if you use more than the available stock.

16. With us you are welcome with all your dogs, there is no limit to breed or number. However, we ask you to take into account that there are several neighbours living here. Of course the dogs are allowed to have fun, we like to see that, but please prevent them from barking all day long. The dogs may not be left unattended in the garden or in the gîte. We would very much like to see your dogs not digging in the garden, should it ever happen then there are barrels earth at the gîtes to refill the holes. If you would like to go away for a day without your dogs, we can look after your dogs in consultation.

17. Power failure: in case of extreme thunderstorms or storms, the power may be temporarily cut. When the storm starts, we ask you to switch off the satellite box and unplug as many plugs as possible (as far as possible). Should the light go out, you can use the flashlight or tea lights.

18. The toilet is connected to a septic tank which means that it is strictly forbidden to flush any material other than PINK toilet paper through the toilet! We provide you with a few rolls and in the supermarkets it can be bought everywhere.

19. Finally, we ask you to occupy the house as if it were your own, feel at home but take good care of it, then the next holidaymakers will also enjoy it and hopefully you will come back again!

We wish you a pleasant stay, and if there are any questions pleas not hesitate to ask!
